

# Kingsgate 1&2 Pool Rules

1. Current Association members, guest members, and guests must check in at the front desk and have an emergency contact form on file prior to entering.
2. All children age 8 and younger must be accompanied by an adult, or a person of at least 12 years of age. Pool staff reserves the right to deny admittance of an unaccompanied child of any age.
3. Pool patrons are asked to dispose of their trash items upon leaving the pool deck.
4. No gum, food, or drinks are allowed in the pool. No glass containers are allowed on the pool deck.
5. No smoking allowed on the premises.
6. Only children age 6 and under are allowed to use the wading pool and must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
7. House guests of 48 hours or longer are allowed free entrance to the pool provided prior arrangements are made with the pool management. Guest fees for the first visit will apply if prior arrangements are not made with the management.
8. A member may bring up to 4 guests or one family at one time. Guests must be accompanied at all times by the member while at the pool. Only four visits per person, per month are allowed each season. No admittance if crowded conditions so warrant. There is a \$3.00 guest fee for each guest per visit—*regardless of whether guests use the pool.* Children, grandchildren, and grandparents of Association members are not required to pay guest fees.
9. No bicycles, skates, skateboards, or scooters are allowed on the pool deck.
10. Any individual with an open sore or wound cannot use the pool. All band aids must be removed and discarded in pool trash cans before entering the pool.
11. Floatation devices, snorkels, and fins are permitted at the discretion of the pool staff.
12. All children age 12 and younger must pass the swim test before being allowed in the deep end unless accompanied by an adult. The test includes swimming one length of the pool on stomach without touching the wall or bottom, followed by treading water for 1 minute.
13. Conduct of a disorderly nature, including abusive or profane language, intoxication, vandalism, or that which affects the enjoyment of the pool by others is prohibited. Violation of pool rules will result in the following penalties:  
1<sup>st</sup> offense—verbal warning  
2<sup>nd</sup> offense—time out, call made to parent/guardian, or patron may be asked to leave the premises.  
3<sup>rd</sup> offense—suspension of pool privileges
14. All non-potty trained children are required to wear a swim diaper when using the pool. Disposable diapers are not allowed in the pool. Diaper changing on the pool deck is prohibited by the health department.
15. The Association is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. Leave valuables at home.
16. All pool users must adhere to posted swimming pool rules.
17. At the discretion of pool management, any individual not following the above rules will have his/her pool use privileges suspended temporarily or for the remainder of the season.
18. The Association reserves the right to close the pool early on very cold or rainy days, as well as to extend open hours on very warm days. In such cases, members will be given as much prior notice as possible.
19. At the discretion of pool staff (1) an “adult only” swim may be called for 10 minutes during any given operating hour, and (2) a lane line may be put in place to facilitate a lap swim. Pool staff will use best efforts to accommodate a member’s requests for a lane line; however, the request may not be possible or the lane line may be removed if the pool is too busy.
